It is our honor and pleasure to welcome you in RALLY GREECE OFFROAD, 12-15 November 2020, a significant International Cross Country event which attracts Competitors from many countries. Our event is governed by FIA and Greek ASN regulations. Sport part of the event consists of three (3) days of competition plus one (1) more day for technical and administrative checks as also competitors briefing, Prologue, Ceremony Start and Welcome cocktail. Special stages on gravel will be run in Northwest part of Greece and specifically in territories of West Macedonia. Race center will be located in KASTORIA area.

Nov.12, Thursday: Administrative Checks (2nd period), Scrutineering, Competitors Briefing, Race Starting Ceremony, Prologue, Welcome Aperitif.

Nov.13, Friday: LEG1 with 200-250km of Special Stages

Nov.14, Saturday: LEG2 with 180-200km of Special Stages

Nov.15, Sunday: LEG3 with 140-160km of Special Stages and Prize Ceremony in early afternoon.

Total Rally length is approximately 900km and Special Stages length is almost 550-600km.

During 8th RALLY GREECE OFFROAD, Organizers will implement certain actions against Covid-19 virus, as specifically described in "Covid-19 Appendix", which is integral part of event's Supplementary Regulation.

EVENT INFORMATION

RALLY GREECE OFFROAD 2020 is the 8th edition of the event and will be run in West Macedonia on 12-15 November 2020. Event is governed by FIA and Greek Motorsport Federation (OMAE) regulations. This rally has a total length approximately 900 km from which almost 550-600km are Special Stages. RALLY GREECE OFFROAD Organizers are proud that this event is the only one in Greece that Special Stages are run to roads closed to other traffic.

Vehicles accepted are: FIA: T1, T2, T3, T4 and OMAE: SSV, TZ1 (TH relevant).

SPECIAL STAGES:

Special Stages will run closed to other traffic. Classification of competitors T1, T2, T3, T4, TZ1, SSV, will be formed according to the fastest time achieved in Special Stages and in respect with penalties as described in event's Supplementary Regulation. Safety equipment required for vehicles and competitors is stated in FIA regulations, in Greek Motorsport Federation regulations and in event's Supplementary Regulation. Speed limits may be

imposed for certain parts of Special Stages. These speed limits must be kept by competitors. Organizers will impose penalties for speed limits violations. A “car-to-car” communication system will be installed to all competition vehicles in order to warn each other and facilitate overtakes. A GPS tracking system will be supplied to all competitors for safety alarm and surveillance by Organizers.

LIAISON SECTIONS:

Liaison sections connect Special Stages and are open to other traffic. Competitors must comply with Greek Traffic Law, road signs and speed limits. Organizers will provide substantial time to competitors in order to complete Liaison Sections in a lawful speed. GPS tracking system will monitor competitors for speed violations.

SUNRISE – SUNSET

During race days, 12-15 November 2020, sun rises at 07:20 and sets at 17:20.

SERVICE PARK

LOCATION

Service Park location to be announced.

Service Park opens 07:00 of NOV 13th and closes 19:00 of NOV 15th.

REMOTE SERVICE PARK: If necessary will be announced with Bulletin.

ACCESS

Service and auxiliary vehicles must enter in the area of Service Park no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the entry time of the 1st competition vehicle.

SERVICE VEHICLES and SERVICE STAFF

During the event, service vehicles must always bear “SERVICE” plates. Vehicles without these plates will not be allowed to enter the Service Park area. Inside Service Park, service staff charged by Competitors must always wear, in a very visible way, their identification card supplied by Organizers at the delivery materials.

IMPORT OF VEHICLES and Spare Parts

FROM EUROPEAN UNION COUNTRIES

Greece is member state of European Union. Competitors/citizens from European Union do not need to have any special custom clearance for temporary import of cars, equipment and spare parts for the purpose of participating in RALLY GREECE OFFROAD. All vehicles must have valid Insurance Green Card.

FROM NON-EUROPEAN UNION COUNTRIES

Non-EU competitors/citizens will need to show their ATA carnet (obtainable from the Chamber of Commerce of the country of origin) to customs authorities at the point of entry into European Union.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

→ Non-E.U. competitors/citizens may enter in Greece only with valid Passport and appropriate issued Visa by Greek Embassy in the country of origin.
